

Summer 2018 Asynchronous Courses

Online (Asynchronous) MBA Courses:

These MBA courses are offered in a primarily asynchronous (online) environment. Zoom will be used if any synchronous sessions are held. Video lessons will be posted online along with all other assignments and projects. There will be deliverables due each week. Students will participate remotely in online course discussions, work on group projects and keep current on assignments through the online course portal. While students will participate remotely on their own schedule, they must meet course assignment deadlines. The content and learning objectives for these courses are the same as our hybrid and in-classroom courses.

This blended course runs from May 7 – June 3, 2018. In addition to the online course requirements, students are required to meet at Bentley (Waltham) 9:00am-5:00pm on the following dates: Saturday, May 12, Sunday, May 13, and Saturday, June 2, 2018. Those students unable to come to campus, may participate synchronously (remotely but at the scheduled time) via Zoom. This is a course in the Leadership concentration and may also be used as an unrestricted elective or an outside elective for certain MS degrees.

Asynchronous=Online These are courses where students participate remotely on their own schedule.

Synchronous=In Person These are courses that meet on Bentley's campus in Waltham, MA. While it is preferred that students attend these sessions in person, those who are unable to do so may participate remotely at the same time the sessions are schedule via Zoom.
