Summer 2021 Information Now in Workday

If you have not already visited the Academics section of Workday to find key summer 2021 registration information, please be sure to do so. In the main Academics section, you will find your assigned Summer 2021 registration date and time. These assignments are based on earned credits. You are encouraged to register as soon as your assigned time permits.

Details regarding summer course offerings, including the course's meeting pattern, modality, etc. can be found in the Bentley Find Course Sections link in the Academics section of Workday. Please note the summer session (May intensive, Summer I, Summer II) in which the course meets.

Reminder: check Workday to see if you have any holds that may prevent registering at your assigned time.

How Should You Approach This Registration?

You will need to register for each summer session (May intensive, Summer I, Summer II) separately. If some of your intended summer courses are prerequisites/corequisites for other summer classes, be sure to register for the sessions in the correct order.

Given each summer session is a separate entity:

- If you are creating schedules for summer registration, you will need a separate schedule for each session.
- You cannot swap courses between sessions; you will only be able to swap courses within the same session.

If a class fills before you are able to enroll in it, you can add yourself to the waitlist via the link at my.bentley.edu. The deadline for adding your name to a summer 2021 waitlist is April 8th at 9am ET. Waitlists will be discontinued on April 13 and then add/swap/drop resumes.

Please note: Add/drop/swap for all summer classes will be closed April 8 at 9am ET though April 13th at 7am ET.

Summer 2021 Term

May 1-week intensive May 10 – 14 one course maximum Summer I: May 17 – July 2 Summer II: July 6 – August 20 three courses maximum per 7-week session 14-week session for internship course

A 7-week Summer I/II course will cover twice as much content and coursework each week vs. a 14-week fall/spring course.

6 total courses maximum for the summer term for students who meet eligibility requirements.

Have you reviewed the Summer 2021 Block Schedule?

Some key things to note with these meeting patterns:

- Some classes meet twice per week, while other classes meet three times per week.
- NASC courses will extend into the next class block, as outlined at <u>bentley.edu/offices/registrar/undergraduate-</u> registration-information.
- Each class meets for 5.5+ hours per week.
- All class blocks represent more instruction time per class meeting than in the fall/spring term, due to the 7week summer session format.

Be Sure to Consider...

As with any course, you should plan on spending 2-3 hours on coursework outside of class for every hour of class meeting time. Given each Summer I/II class meets for 5.5+ hours per week, you should therefore plan on spending 11+ hours per week on coursework per class.

In light of this academic undertaking, please carefully consider:

- The number of hours per week you will be dedicating to work or other commitments.
- Ensuring you have time for self-care, including adequate sleep, connecting with others, and downtime.
- Carving out time to relax and recharge, both to remain healthy and to re-energize for the fall term. Ultimately, your approach to the summer will be personalized based on your unique circumstances. We encourage you to be thoughtful and realistic about your time, energy, and focus as overcommitting could result in a very challenging summer.
