ATTENTION BENTLEY STUDENTS ABROAD IN AUSTRIA, DENMARK, FRANCE, GERMANY, GREECE, HUNGARY, THE NETHERLANDS, SPAIN, SWITZERLAND

Late on March 11, The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) updated their <u>travel notice for Europe</u>, increasing to warning level 3 "avoid all non-essential travel" for your country. Bentley University REQUIRES that study abroad students in these locations make arrangements to immediately return to their permanent home.

Please contact your airline to arrange a flight to arrive no later than March 18. Any student who has difficulty securing travel by that date please contact your study abroad advisor for guidance by email or phone 1.781.891.3474.

Travel Plans

Once you have secured a departure, please report your departure date, departure city, arrival date and arrival city to your study abroad advisor. Monitor the <u>Department of Homeland Security</u>, to ensure you have the most up to date information regarding President Trump's March 11 Presidential Proclamation as you prepare to travel. All travelers returning to the United States from a country with a level 2 or 3 warning designation by the CDC may be subject to additional screening measures upon entry to the United States.

Academic Continuation

Follow guidance provided by your individual study abroad program. Notify on site advisors and professors of your departure and your willingness to continue remotely. Save all coursework to date and save all contact information of your professors. If you do not already have academic guidance from your program on course continuation, we will continue to work to support you. Your study abroad advisor will advise you further.

Student Support over the Weekend

Contact your program's onsite staff, local emergency contact, int'l insurance hotline, or Bentley University Police at +1.781.891.3131 whose dispatchers can reach the Cronin Office of International Education team. The International Education team is on standby to advise students throughout the weekend if you will have not yet departed.
