ATTENTION BENTLEY STUDENTS ABROAD IN AUSTRALIA AND SINGAPORE

Media reports released today (March 19, 2020) indicate that the <u>US State State Department</u> is likely to announce a Level 4 travel advisory applying to all international travel, its most severe warning. The advisory would instruct all Americans abroad to either return to the United States or prepare to shelter in place, given the global threat of the coronavirus outbreak.

In anticipation of an imminent increase in US State Department warning as well as potential for further travel disruption, Bentley University REQUIRES that study abroad students in Australia and Singapore make immediate arrangements to return to their permanent home if they have not done so already.

As of this writing, the US State Department has a global "reconsider travel" <u>advisory</u> and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has a global "practice enhanced precaution" <u>advisory</u> and level 2 alert for Australia and Singapore. We anticipate that those alert levels may change in the very near future.

Travel Plans

Please contact your airline to arrange a flight as soon as possible. We recommend a departure date as soon as reasonably possible and suggest no later than March 25. Any student who has difficulty securing travel or has serious concerns about feasibility of returning to their permanent residence, please contact your study abroad advisor for guidance.

Once you have secured a departure, please report your departure date, departure city, arrival date and arrival city to your study abroad advisor. Monitor the <u>Department of Homeland Security</u>, or your home country equivalent to ensure you have the most up to date information regarding entry into your home country as you prepare to travel. Travelers returning to the United States may be subject to additional screening measures upon entry to the United States, but thus far there have been no reports from Bentley students of entry difficulties.

Flight Reimbursement

Bentley will subsidize one economy change fee or one economy ticket to your home country up to a maximum of \$1,500. Send your flight itinerary and your receipt to both your study abroad advisor and to ga_acctspayable@bentley.edu. Receipts are subject to review by Financial

Operations and will be processed as soon as possible.

Academic Continuation

Follow guidance provided by your individual study abroad program. Notify on site advisors and professors of your departure and your willingness to continue remotely. Save all coursework to date and save all contact information of your professors. If you do not already have academic guidance from your program on course continuation, Bentley faculty and advisors will advise you further how to earn academic credit.
