Dear Spring 2020 Study Abroad Students,

This message confirms that **the new Grading Policy for Spring 2020 IS AVAILABLE** to spring 2020 study abroad students. Choose from the following two options:

Option A: Students can choose to keep their study abroad letter grades for all of their courses this semester.

- Reminder: a semester abroad is GPA Neutral: translated letter grades appear on the Bentley transcript with an asterisk indicating their exclusion from GPA calculation

Option B: Students can choose to have all of their letter grades converted to Pass/Fail this semester (i.e., you will not be able to choose individual courses to be converted to Pass/Fail).

- If you choose to have your letter grades converted to Pass/Fail, letter grades of A through D- will be converted to "Pass" by the Registrar's Office.
- All letter grades of F will remain F.

STUDY ABROAD STUDENTS WILL HAVE DIFFERENT DEADLINES

You will receive a notification from your study abroad advisor with your specific deadline to declare Pass/Fail after your study abroad program is complete and grades have been reported to Bentley. If you do not select one of these options, you will receive GPA Neutral letter grades for all of your study abroad courses.
