Process and Basics

- Looking for Papers that are high quality, provide new knowledge or novel reinterpretation of existing knowledge
- Double Blind Peer Review Process
- Expect review process to take time not 'send and forget'.
 - Conditional Acceptance
 - Revise and Resubmit
 - Formatting
- Helpful: working directly with a faculty advisor as you go through submission and review process
- Caveat: Current Status of Journal
