- All course prerequisites must be satisfied. Please note that the stated prerequisites of a course may also have a prerequisite that must be satisfied. • GR500 and GR600 level courses are designated on the course schedule as “D”, “P”, or “AL”. The “D” section is reserved for students whose primary degree is Full-Time MBA and the “P” sections are reserved for all other MS and Part-Time MBA students. The “AL” section is reserved for Accelerated Online MBA students with a limited number of seats open to students in other programs.
