
Experiences with Sexual Violence


Respondents who experienced at least one incident of sexual violence at least one time since the beginning of the current school year.

Types of sexual violence include unwanted incidents of being fondled, kissed, or rubbed up against, attempted sexual penetration, sexual penetration, attempted oral sex, and oral sex. Respondents most commonly experienced being fondled, kissed, or rubbed up against.





Prior Experience with Sexual Violence

Quick Takes

- Fifteen percent (15%) of all respondents reported that someone had or attempted to have unwanted sexual contact with them prior to going to college.
- Nineteen percent (19%) of women respondents experienced unwanted sexual contact prior to college.
- Almost one in ten (9%) of men respondents experienced unwanted sexual contact prior to college.
