Library Licensed Electronic Resource Use

Bentley Library makes electronic resources available under licenses that restrict access to current Bentley University students, faculty, and staff. Most licenses permit access by unaffiliated library users who visit the physical Library; this includes, but is not exclusive to, Bentley alumni and retirees, Boston Library Consortium members, and Waltham residents.

Bentley Library's use of electronic resources is governed by federal copyright law and vendor license agreements that restrict usage to noncommercial, educational, and scholarly research purposes.

Prohibited activities include:

- Sharing of passwords
- Substantial and systematic downloading of electronic resource content, either by manual means or through the use of robots, spiders, or other scripted methods
- Posting of copyrighted material on publicly available websites
- Use, resale, or sharing of licensed information for commercial purposes

The University does not share user identification information with the Library's electronic resource providers. These providers, however, do monitor usage and may block access for the entire University community if they detect excessive or illegal use originating with an authorized user. The University may investigate the source of any excessive or illegal use.
