Dear Fall 2021 Study Abroad Students,

Your study abroad term is coming to an end soon and it is time to start planning for your return to the U.S. and Bentley campus. Please see our guide below to ensure safe travels during the winter break and smooth return to Bentley for spring term 2022.

Entry to the United States

1. Proof of Vaccination and Negative Covid Test

You must show documentation of vaccination and a negative test result from a sample taken within three days of travel. Even if you are fully vaccinated, you should be prepared to present documentation of your vaccination status alongside your negative test result.

2. Acceptable Vaccines

The CDC has determined that for purposes of travel to the United States, vaccines accepted will include FDA approved or authorized and World Health Organization (WHO) emergency use listed (EUL) vaccines. See the [CDC's website](#) for more information.

3. Acceptable Covid Tests

Both nucleic acid amplification tests (NAATs), such as a PCR test, and antigen tests qualify. A self-test can be used if it meets the requirements of the order including real-time proctoring by a telehealth service affiliated with the manufacturer of the test and that generates a test result that can be reviewed by the airline before boarding.
