



New Hire's Step by Step Guide: Onboarding & Workday Tasks

Workday is a cloud based system used to house employee information. Forget the mounds of paper you are used to filling out and look for the electronic tasks in your Workday inbox to complete your onboarding. Below are the new hire tasks and instructions that must be completed in your first week.

Task #1 Complete Form I-9

As part of the process to onboard new employees, Bentley University is required to validate that all new hires are authorized to work in the United States. The Form I-9 is the required form from the U.S. government for this purpose. We have employed an electronic I-9 process for your convenience.

STEP 1: Please complete all fields in section 1 of the Form I-9 electronically in Workday. **Section 1 of the Form I-9 must be completed on or before your first day.**

STEP 2: Please make an appointment with HR to meet on campus to complete Section 2 of your Form I-9 and verify your documentation. Step 2 must be complete within the **first three days of your start date.** To schedule an appointment email kmanning@bentley.edu.
