## ***Tribute to Tony Buono***

*Pioneering Teacher, Professional Program Originator & Leader, Researcher*

After 43 years, this spring semester marks Professor Anthony Buono's (Tony) well-deserved retirement from Bentley University (1979-2022). The Hoffman Center for Business Ethics recognizes and honors his foundational, pioneering work in business ethics. Tony's legacy looms large in the HCBE.

Among his many accomplishments, Tony co-facilitated the Global Business Ethics Teaching Workshop for 25 years, won numerous grants from the State Street Foundation to expand the Workshop internationally, created the Global Business Ethics Symposium, and founded the Alliance for Ethics and Social Responsibility, which was instrumental in integrating the HCBE into the Bentley community. He also oversaw Bentley's involvement in the United Nation Global Compact's Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME) initiative, and was honored as a "PRME Pioneer" during the program's 10-year anniversary meeting at UN Headquarters in New York City.

His collegial and inclusive style was part of the energy that not only propelled HCBE's reputation and good works in ethics at and beyond Bentley's boundaries, but also paved the way for many students' and professors' interest and lived experience of 'being good by doing good.' We honor him here and wish him well in his journey beyond Bentley.
